BOG 23.2	<p><b>PROPOSAL FOR CONFIRMATION OF THE APPROVAL OF 22<sup>ND</sup> MEETING OF BOARD OF GOVERNORS BY CIRCULATION</b></p> <p><b>Background:</b></p> <p>This is to place before the Board, the proposal for confirmation of the approval of the 22nd meeting of the Board obtained through circulation on the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020. **V. Payment regarding the purchase of Mechanical Equipment:** The NPIU has suggested to complete all installations and clear all ready invoices by November 2020 to expedite the total expenditure. Accordingly, the payment for the purchase of Mechanical Department was made with 5% GST invoice amounting to Rs. 1,02,51,150.00. In this regard following points are considered:

(i) PO of ME Department equipment was issued on **19<sup>th</sup> February 2020** with **5% GST** amounting **Rs. 1, 02, 51, 150.00**. The amount Rs. 1, 02, 51, 150.00 was approved in the BoG. M/S Maverick Technologies has delivered and completed installation in the month of November



2020 whereas the Firm supposed to deliver the equipment within **3 months** of issuing PO i.e. **May 2020**.

(ii) M/S Maverick Technologies has issued Invoice on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020 and 18<sup>th</sup> September 2020 total amounting Rs. 1, 02, 51, 150.00 (inclusive 5% GST).

(iii) The **DSIR Certificate** of Institute was expired on **31.08.2020**.

(iv) In this regard, SPIU was communicated and the corresponding reply was **"You are requested to complete the payments to the vendor as per the PO issued in the month of February. Also, you are informed that till the new DSIR is accepted at your end additional GST amount should be kept in your custody so that if you are not getting the benefit of GST exemption you will be able to disburse the additional GST amount to Govt."**

(v) The Committee constituted by the Director also examined the issue of GST rate for clearing the bill for procurement of equipment of ME Dept. The detailed minutes is attached at **Annexure - II of BOG 23.3 at page no 27**.

(vi) The matter was further referred to IAO and his comment may be reproduced as.... "Pl. refer to my earlier mail related to this subject. Through oversight the date of invoice has been shown as 19.02.2020 instead of 18.9.2020 i.e. after the expiry of DSIR. **Since they accepted the order and raised the invoice @ 5% Payment may be released considering 5% GST.**" The details mail is attached **Annexure - III of BOG 23.3 at page no. 28-29**.

(vii) Given the SPIU comments and recommendations as above Rs. 1,02,51,150.00 (inclusive 5% GST) as mentioned in the PO and Invoice have been paid. If the payment of 18% GST does arise at a later date, the additional GST of 13% shall be borne from the allocated funds meant for procurement under NIC-CPP. Highlight that procurement scheduled under NIC-CPP has not been initiated till date for want of registration and the possibility for future procurement could be hampered as the Institute is supposed to wind up all procurement by 31.12.2020 vide SPIU mail dated: 12.10.2020; indicating the ample fund position under the Procurement Head of TEQIP-III.

This is put up for information and approval of the Board.

#### **VI. Action Plan (Jan.-Mar. 2021):**

TEQIP-III Project closure has been extended from 30.09.2020 to 31.03.2021 vide mail received from NPIU on 11.09.2020. Hence, the Action Plan for 4<sup>th</sup> Qtr of 2020-21 (Jan.-Mar., 2021) is required to be



submitted to SPIU by 11<sup>th</sup> Dec., 2020. In this regard, meeting was conducted with all HoDs, Deans, TEQIP III officials, CPC and minutes is attached **Annexure - IV of BOG 23.3 at page no. 30-32.** Accordingly, Action plan approved by the Chairperson, BoG cum Director was submitted to the SPIU. The action plan is summarised as below and the detail is attached at **Annexure - V of BOG 23.3 at page no 33-40:**

ZOTE, DEPUTY REGISTRAR FOR CONFIRMATION IN THE POST OF DEPUTY REGISTRAR</b></p> <p><b>Background</b> The Board is hereby informed that a Writ Petition submitted by Mrs. Lalthianghlimi Zote, Deputy Registrar in the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Aizawl Bench vide Writ Petition (C) No. 114/2020 was received on the 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2020. The Writ Petition is against the Union of India represented by the Secretary, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, the Director General, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, the Director, NIT Mizoram and Chairman, BoG of NIT Mizoram.</p> <p>The Deputy Registrar being deeply aggrieved by the fact that after serving the Institute for 9 years 3 months and 5 days (as on 10.12.2020), her service at NIT Mizoram has not been made permanent/confirmed even after the satisfactorily completed the stipulated probation period.</p> <p>Mrs. L. Zote, joined the Institute on the 06<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 vide the                      Appointment                      Order                      No.                      D/Non-</p>



Faculty-Recruit/4 dated 11.07.2011 in the post of Deputy Registrar advertisement in may 2011. Her service confirmation after completion of 1 year probation period was not considered on ground that there was no sanctioned post of Deputy Registrar. The 2<sup>nd</sup> BoG meeting on 08.03.2014 adjusted the post of Deputy Registrar against the post of Assistant Registrar. Even after the adjustment of the post, her service remained no confirmed till date.

That, the incumbent Officer in her Petition has specifically referred the Ministry of Personnel, PG & Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training Circular issued vide No. 28020/3/2018-Estt. (C) dated 11.03.2019 regarding the Master Circular on Probation/Confirmation in Central Services. That, she further alleged that the Master Circular was referred to in the agenda note of the 21<sup>st</sup> BoG meeting on 28.09.2020 which however, was not taken into consideration in its decision. That, under sl.no-24 this Master Circular provides that-


*"Confirmation is de-linked from the availability of permanent vacancy in the grade. In other words, an officer who has successfully completed the probation, as prescribed under relevant rules, may be considered for confirmation. Consequent upon the above decision of delinking confirmation from the availability of permanent post, it emerges that confirmation will be done only once in the service of an officer which will be in the entry grade post/service/cadre provided further confirmation shall be necessary when there is fresh entry subsequently in any other post/service/cadre by way of direct recruitment or otherwise. A specific order of confirmation should be issued when the case is cleared from all angles"*

The decision of the BoG in the 21<sup>st</sup> meeting on 28.09.2020 was that for the post of Deputy Registrar (PB3 + GP 7600/-) the Institute requires matching savings other than the post of SASO (PB3 + GP 5400/-). In the absence of the bare minimum requirement of Non - Teaching posts not to mention the need for matching savings, the Board requests the Institute to submit requirement of posts once again to be attended in the Ministry. A letter vide No. NITMZ/C-75-2/2019/858 dated 14.10.2020 was therefore, submitted to the Ministry reflecting the actual problems faced by the Institute thereby providing justifications for sanction of 32 post due for creation/sanction in 2021-22 as per the standard Student:Teaching Faculty ratio of 1:12 and Teaching:Non-Teaching ratio of 1:1.1.

The matter is therefore, placed before the Board for favour of information and suggestion on the matter may be discussed upon.
